## Admissions/Applications Process:

(Applications for the fall of 2010 will be accepted from January 20, 2010 to June 7, 2010)

Listed below are the steps required for entry into the Associate Degree Nursing program at Southeastern Community College. The steps are provided as a guideline and, in all cases, the student should work closely with a Southeastern Community College Admissions staff member and his/her assigned advisor during the application process.

1. Complete and return the Southeastern Community College Admissions Application.
2. Take the college placement assessment in the Counseling Center. Placement assessment dates and times are available in the Counseling/Admissions Office or at [www.sccnc.edu](http://www.sccnc.edu). SAT or ACT scores may substitute.
3. Request official high school and college transcripts are sent to SCC. Applicants must have a high school diploma or GED.
4. Applicants must have successfully completed the following requirements with a "C" grade or better, or test out through the placement assessment:
  - a. RED 090: Improved College Reading (higher level English may substitute)
  - b. ENG 090: Composition Strategies (a higher level English may substitute)
  - c. MAT 060: Essential Mathematics (must be current within 3 years of the application deadline)
  - d. MAT 070, Introductory Algebra (must be current within 3 years of the application deadline) A higher level college math course may substitute.
5. Applicant must hold a valid certificate of CNA training and current listing on the NC CNA registry, or a current unencumbered license to practice as an LPN in North Carolina.
6. During the Spring semester prior to Admission in the Fall, the applicant must be enrolled in or have previously completed the following:
  - ACA 115: Success and Study Skills
  - CIS 110: Introduction To Computers
  - NUR 117: Pharmacology (must be current within 2 years of application deadline)

Once the program requirements above are completed, the student must meet with a member of the Admissions Office staff no later than June 7, 2010 to complete the application process. (Students must apply each year, and may apply for admission to only one program at a time). There can be only one (1) entry level position into the ADN program in a five-year period (five years calculated from the last date on enrollment in the program).

Applicants are chosen for admission to the nursing program based on completion of a student readiness checklist (see reverse) and a comparison of grades in NUR 117. Acceptance into the ADN program will be announced no later than June 25, 2010. The number of applicants chosen will be determined by the nursing department based on space and resources available.
