

INSTRUCTIONAL, LABORATORY, AND OTHER FACILITIES AVAILABLE

Instructional, laboratory, and other school facilities associated with academic programs

Southeastern Community College is located in Whiteville, North Carolina. The campus includes 15 buildings. All facilities are handicapped accessible with a few exceptions as noted with (*). The facilities include the following:

Building	Description
A	Administration Building – Offices of the President, SCC Foundation, Curriculum Instruction, Cashier, Operations/Finance, JobLink Career Center, Student Development Services (Admissions, Counseling, Financial Aid, Public Information and Registrar’s Office), Upstairs Art Gallery; Early College High School, classrooms and offices for business programs and college transfer.
B	Cosmetology, engineering and industrial programs; Basic Skills Lab (Adult Basic Education and General Educational Development), Open Computer Lab, Electrical/Electronics Technology Program and classrooms.
C	Science and Environmental Science Technology classrooms, laboratories, and offices.
CAR	Cartrette Technology - Ag Bio Technology, Broadcast Technology and Information Technology departments. Distance Learning Offices
D	Auditorium, Music classrooms* and offices* and college printing and audiovisual facilities. Art classrooms, (a studio for drawing, painting, sculpture, and pottery).
G	Student Center, Student Activities Office, Campus Grill, Gymnasium including a well-equipped health/wellness laboratory and locker rooms; Forest Management Technology program, Talent Search and Upward Bound programs, classrooms and faculty/staff offices.
H	Early Childhood Education program and the Child Development Center.
L	Library with spacious reading and study areas as well as two meeting rooms.
M	Multipurpose structure that houses offices for Developmental Education; Academic Skills labs; Retired Senior volunteer Program (RSVP); the Air Conditioning, Heating and Refrigeration, Criminal Justice, Basic Law Enforcement Training, and Welding programs; computer labs, general-purpose classrooms, meeting rooms, and faculty offices.
N	Bookstore; Medical Laboratory Technology, Pharmacy Technology, and Phlebotomy programs; classrooms and faculty offices.
R	Nursing and Allied Health programs, classrooms, labs and faculty offices.

S	Shipping/Receiving, Maintenance, and Carpentry Shop.
T	Business and Industry Skills Training Center; Continuing Education Division; Small Business Center; Hispanic Initiative, and EDU-Cable television production facility.
Trailer 6	Classroom and office for the Park Ranger Technology program.
Trailer 9	Classroom for the Human Resource Development (HRD) program.

Academic Skills Lab

The Academic Skills Lab offers a variety of services, including the following:

1. Free peer and staff tutoring for most courses offered by SCC.
2. Computer-assisted tutoring for many basic courses.
3. Computer-assisted enrichment activities in some courses.
