

SPECIAL FACILITIES AND SERVICES AVAILABLE TO DISABLED STUDENTS

Students with Disabilities

SCC does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission or access to its programs, services, or activities of individuals who meet essential eligibility requirements. The college will provide reasonable accommodations for documented disabilities of individuals who are eligible to receive or participate in college programs, services, or activities.

The Vice President of Operations and Finance has been designated to coordinate compliance with the nondiscrimination requirements contained in the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. Information concerning provisions of the ADA and the rights provided there under are available from the ADA counselor. Student Development Services provides an ADA counselor to assist students in requesting disability related accommodations. Individuals who require reasonable accommodation for a disability should make this requirement known to the ADA counselor as soon as possible (preferably, at least thirty days prior to the scheduled date for the program, service, or activity) so that the college will have time to make appropriate arrangements. Individuals accompanied by a personal assistant while on campus must provide the ADA counselor with documentation that includes sufficient reasons for the assistance.
