When should students apply for transfer?

Admissions deadlines vary from institution to institution. Students should contact the admissions office of the particular institution to which they are applying to find out application deadlines. In general, students should begin the application process two semesters before they intend to transfer.

The following is a simple guide to assist you in a smooth transfer :

When you have earned 1-29 credits:

If you are unsure of a major or four-year college, start exploring. Visit the University Center, A-121. See Counseling & Admissions for assistance and to take a personality or career interest inventory.

Visit information tables staffed by four-year college representatives. Check Rammail for dates of recruiter visits.

Learn about admission requirements of colleges and universities to which you may want to transfer. Find out about required GPA, pre-requisite courses, majors, foreign language requirements, and deadlines.

Work to finish general AA or AS requirements following your Individual Graduation Plan (IGP). See your advisor for assistance.

When you have earned 30-45 credits:

Visit university and college campuses. Contact their Admissions office to arrange a tour. Ask if they have a transfer information session.

When you have earned 46-60 credits:

Check application deadlines and apply to your intended schools.

Request official transcripts for SCC and all other colleges attended to be sent to your baccalaureate transfer school.
