
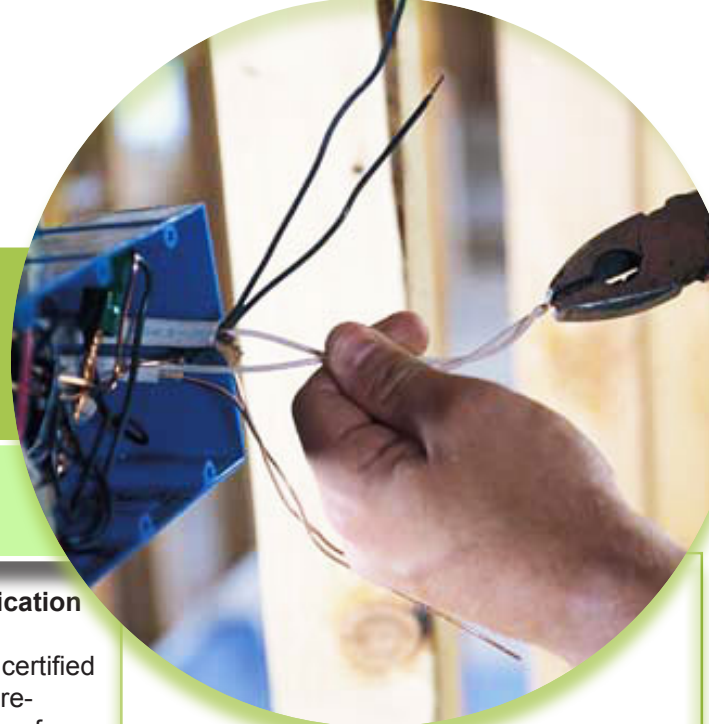


Certification & License Renewal
