The Associate in Arts degree program is designed to prepare students to transfer into a baccalaureate degree program in an art, business, communications, social sciences or similar area. The course options allow for alignment in many programs with many area institutions including, but not limited, to East Carolina University, Fayetteville State University, Mount Olive College, North Carolina Wesleyan College, University of North Carolina at Greensboro, University of North Carolina at Pembroke, and the University of North Carolina Wilmington providing 60 hours of credit towards a four-year degree. Students should work with their advisor to maximize the number of credit hours that will transfer into a baccalaureate program at these and other institutions.

- * Hours may be required as indicated by placement scores increasing the number of semester hours required for program completion.
- + Three courses must be selected for the Humanities/Fine Arts/Communication and Social/Behavioral Sciences areas. From the three courses selected in each area, at least two different disciplines must be chosen.
- ^ An additional 13-14 SHC of courses should be selected from courses classified as general education within the Comprehensive Articulation Agreement. Students should select these courses based on their major and transfer university.
- P Up to 14 semester credit hours of Additional Coursework must be selected from the list of transfer courses to reach a total of 60 SHC for the program. Students should select these courses based on their intended major and the transfer university.

NOTE: While students will be eligible for transfer to an UNC institution if the student completes a minimum of 30 semester hours of transferable credits (as described above), it is recommended that the student complete an associate in arts or associate in science degree prior to transfer. Students completing a credential prior to transfer demonstrate higher levels of success in coursework in the university system. Students must meet the receiving university's foreign language and/or health and physical education requirements, if applicable, prior to or after transfer to the senior institution.
