- * Hours may be required as indicated by placement scores increasing the number of semester hours required for program completion.
- ^ Up to 7 SHC of courses should be selected from courses classified as general education within the Comprehensive Articulation Agreement. Students should select these courses based on their major and transfer university.
- P An additional 14 SHC of Other Required Hours must be selected from the list of transfer courses classified as pre-major, elective or general education courses to reach a total of 60 SHC for the program. Students should select these courses based on their intended major and the transfer university.

NOTE: While students will be eligible for transfer to an UNC institution if the student completes a minimum of 30 semester hours of transferable credits (as described above), it is recommended that the student complete an associate in arts or associate in science degree prior to transfer. Students completing a credential prior to transfer demonstrate higher levels of success in coursework in the university system. Students must meet the receiving university's foreign language and/or health and physical education requirements, if applicable, prior to or after transfer to the senior institution.
