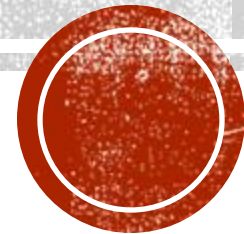

WHY USE THE WILLIAMSON LIBRARY INSTEAD OF THE OPEN INTERNET?

- The open internet does not contain all the knowledge in the world!
- Information on the open internet is not always reliable.
- The Williamson Library has paid subscriptions to hundreds of electronic databases, journals, and reference materials that are peer and scholarly reviewed, which means the information you are reading has been verified by experts in the respective discipline.
- The Williamson Library houses thousands of print materials and access to millions more that are available for free that you would otherwise have to buy.
- The Williamson Library has trained personnel that can help you with your research and location of needed materials.



WILLIAMSON LIBRARY SERVICES

- Over 37,000 books and reference materials.
- Multiple print periodicals and newspapers.
- Multiple online databases including e-books and NC Live.
 - Note: Please contact the library for the current NC Live password.
- Access to most lending libraries in the United States.
- ChatStaff, an online library chat service.
- Tutoring services, both online and face-to-face.
- Access to Wifi and printing services.

USING THE LINK:

- You may have to select the correct library when you click on the link, but it should take to you this page.
- You'll notice a drop down menu to the right of the search box. The following is an explanation of the menu:
- Words or phrase: useful when you aren't sure of the author or title
- Author: useful when you know at least the author's last name
- Title: useful when you know the title of the book
- Subject: useful as a secondary search to words and phrases
- Series: useful when you are searching for books in a series (i.e. Harry Potter)
- Periodical title: useful when you are searching periodicals

SEARCH RESULTS

- Doing a search for the author Stephen King yields the following results.
- Looking at the first result, you'll see highlighted in yellow the call number located in the General Collection. We use the Library of Congress Classification System.
- If you are in the library, we will assist you locating the book in our general collection. Our normal check-out period is two weeks but we can renew it for an additional two weeks if requested.
- If you are a distance learning student and wish for us to mail you the book, we can accommodate your request. Please call us at 910-788-6386 during normal business hours to process your request.
- Search tip: Always use the bar in green for navigation of the search tools instead of the back button on your browser.
