Due to the competitive nature of the application process, the fact that enrollment in each program is limited, and the difficulty level of the nursing curriculum, students seeking admission are encouraged to take as many related/required general education courses from the appropriate Individual Graduation Plan (D45660) as possible before application to the nursing program. Additional courses completed from the A45110 IGP may increase competitiveness of PN applicants (see the current Application Points Rubric). Discuss current standing with your pre-nursing advisor.

Students eligible to apply for admission to the nursing program who have been previously enrolled in a nursing program at another college will be required to provide a letter from the dean/director/faculty chair of the program stating that they were not dismissed for issues regarding safety or gross negligence in the clinical setting.
